Duties and Responsibilities of the Vice President

The primary role of the Vice-President is to assume the responsibilities of the President Elect in the event of her/his absence. Often, the vice president also carries out special assignments as requested by the president or the Board of Directors. If an organization has multiple vice-presidents, each is typically charged with a set of unique responsibilities.

Procedures:

- 1. The Vice President is in the succession to the Presidency.
- 2. Be willing to become the President Elect in the coming year.
- 3. The Vice President is a voting member of the Board of Directors.
- 4. Attend all Board Meetings when possible
- 5. Familiarize self with Minutes, Financial Report, and Agenda, monthly.
- 6. Be responsible for duties as requested by the President or Board of Directors.
- 7. Be ready to assume the duties of the President in the event of his/her absence.
